Tim Nichols gave Borough Council an update on the progress of the work to reduce the inflow and infiltration into the sewer system.

1. Inside water meter reading is continuing – 20-30 sump pumps
2. Video Pipe Services – starting TV & grouting – August 9, 2004
3. Smoke Testing to begin August 31, 2004.

**Roberts & Losito Well:** Borough Council is interested in purchasing the well located on the Roberts & Losito property on Baltimore Pike to incorporate it into our municipal water system.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:**

**Chambers Way – Permit Parking:**

Chief Galloway informed Borough Council that he has received a copy of a permit parking ordinance for Chambers Way. He recommended a petition would need to be signed by more than half of the residents before Borough Council proceeds. He proposed to require permits for vehicles from 7 am. To 4 pm on weekdays.

**Tasers:** Chief Galloway informed Borough Council that there have been several lawsuits involving the use of Tasers. He also stated that a federal study has not been done concerning the safety of the tasers.
