FINANCE ISSUES:

PUBLIC SAFETY:

North Guernsey Road – speed check: Chief Galloway informed Borough Council that the West Grove Police Department ran a speed check on North Guernsey Road. The vehicles observed were traveling between 30-31 miles per hour.

Evergreen Street and Prospect Avenue – traffic study: The Borough received a letter requesting that a traffic study be conducted by PennDOT on Evergreen Street and Prospect Avenues to see if the speed limit could be reduced to 25 mph. Chief Galloway will request the traffic study

PUBLIC WORKS:

Tim Nichols, Superintendent, informed Borough Council that he had been contacted by the Clean Air Council about signing a statement of intent to initiate diesel retrofitting project. Submission of the form indicates the Borough's intent to participate in grant funded projects to retrofit fleet vehicles. This is not legally binding and the Borough is free to act otherwise should circumstances change. Borough Council supported signing the statement of intent to initiate diesel retrofitting project.
