**PUBLIC WORKS:**

**Revitalization Project Update:** The Contractor is proceeding with completion of the project. Several residents had concerns about the yards and have sent correspondence to Mayor Black. Borough Council recommended that the residents work with the Borough Office to get the matters resolved.

**Corrective Action Plan:** DEP has approved the submitted Corrective Action Plan for the West Grove Authority Sewer Plant and the Borough employees are proceeding with the list of the Source Identification and Reduction Tasks to be completed as part of the approved plan.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:**

**POLICE POLICY AND PROCEDURES MANUAL:** H. A. Thomson, Borough's insurance company, required that the West Grove Borough Police Department update their Policy and Procedures Manual. A copy was included for Borough Council's review for their approval. Borough Council felt that they did not have sufficient time to review the manual and will table the approval until the August 1, 2007 Borough Council Meeting.

**Route 841/Chatham Road Intersection Improvements:** The Borough has not received a concept plan for the proposed round about for the intersection. Farley Fry, P.E., requested input as to whether Borough Council would consider right turns only on and off Harmony Road onto Evergreen Street. Borough Council would like to see that Harmony Road onto Evergreen Street remain as it is by synchronizing the traffic light to permit vehicles to make a left hand turn on demand.
