VISITORS:

Kim Ringler, Avon Grove Library: Mrs. Ringler discussed with Borough Council the possibility of Andrew Jarvis installing a brick patio behind the Arts & Craft Room for his Eagle Scout Project. Mr. William Wells will be assisting Mr. Jarvis in the design of the patio and will oversee the installation. The Avon Grove Library has started a fund raiser to purchase bricks (small brick - \$50.00 & large brick \$150.00) in memory or in honor of

PUBLIC WORKS:

Sharp Alley: Mr. Johnson requested that a yellow line be painted on the curb on West Summit before Sharp Alley to prevent parking. Tim Nichols, Superintendent said that he would have the curb painted.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

Chief Galloway informed Borough Council that he is reviewing several sample policies for use of the tasers.

OLD BUSINESS:

Judicial Sale – 163 Myrtle Avenue, West Grove, PA: Glenn R. Diehl, Esq., Borough Solicitor discussed the procedure for the judicial sale of 163 Myrtle Avenue on June 4, 2004. Borough Council authorized Mr. Diehl to bid as high as \$40,000.00 for the property.

McFadden Subdivision: Mr. Diehl, Borough Solicitor, informed Borough Council that the review letter will be going out by the end of the week.

Borough Subdivision: Mr. Diehl informed Borough Council that the process of obtaining the NPDES permit for the Borough property is preceding and hopefully the permit will be issued shortly. The new storm water management procedures have delayed the approval process.
